### **Junior League of Mobile to Retire Cookbooks**

The Junior League of Mobile (JLM) has decided to officially retire its current cookbooks, *Bay Tables* and *Best of the Bay*. A limited number of each book is still available. *Bay Tables* is currently being offered at a reduced price of \$15 and *Best of the Bay* is just \$8. Copies of both books can be purchased at JLM Headquarters (57 North Sage Avenue, Mobile), at [www.juniorleaguemobile.org](http://www.juniorleaguemobile.org) and at local retailers.

*Bay Tables* was introduced at Christmas Jubilee in 1998 and features more than 300 fabulous recipes. Each recipe was chosen for its originality and use of fresh ingredients. Recipes range from 30-minute entrees to show-stopping desserts. *Bay Tables* also features interesting facts about Mobile and great cooking tips. In 2002, the publication was proclaimed the official cookbook of the City of Mobile.

*Best of the Bay* is a historical compilation of two retired JLM cookbooks, *Recipe Jubilee!* and *One of a Kind*. *Recipe Jubilee!* debuted in 1964 and sold over 160,000 copies. The publication won national recognition from *Bon Appetit* and *The New York Times* and was selected for the Walter S. McIlhenny Hall of Fame Award. *One of a Kind* was introduced in 1981 and sold more than 100,000 copies. In 1993, it was awarded membership in the *Southern Living* Hall of Fame. *Best of the Bay* has tried and true recipes with invaluable tips and modern twists to make for perfect entertaining.
